MEETING MINUTES

The Township Board of Washington Township, Marion County, Indiana met at the Washington Township Government Center located at 5302 N. Keystone Avenue, Suite E, Indianapolis, Indiana, 46220 on Tuesday, October 14, 2025.

The Board Members present included Emily Gurwitz, Emily Denton, Eric Poole, Melissa Fisher, and David Smith. Also in attendance were Frank T. Short, Washington Township Trustee; Beth Marsh, Township Accountant; Bette Bowman, Township Emergency Assistance Supervisor; Kip Tew, Township Attorney and Steve Poore, Township Small Claims Court Judge.

Board President Gurwitz called the meeting to order at 6:05p.m. and then led everyone present in the Pledge of Allegiance.

The first item of business was the approval August 2025 Financials. Beth Marsh, Township Accountant presented the Financials. There was a motion made by Board Member Smith and seconded by Board Member Denton to approve the August 2025 Financials as presented. The motion passed 5-0.


The next item on the agenda was the discussion and approval of the 2026 Township Annual Budget and the 2026 Tax Rates for the Township General and Township Assistance Funds. Trustee Short reviewed the Budget and Tax Rates as previously presented. Township Accountant Marsh answered a few questions from Board Members. After that, a motion was made by Board Member Poole and seconded by Board Member Denton to approve the 2026 Township Annual Budget and the 2026 Tax Rates for the Township General and Township Assistance Funds. The motion passed 5-0.

The next item on the agenda was the discussion and approval of the 2026 Salary Resolution. Trustee Short reviewed the 2026 Salary Resolution as previously presented. This year the Salary Resolution is based on a 3% increase for all employees. A motion was made by Board Member Fisher and seconded by Board Member Smith to approve the 2026 Salary Resolution. The motion passed 5-0.

The next agenda item was the Trustee's Report. Trustee Short had no report.



The meeting adjourned at 6:40 p.m.






